<p>Read a book of your choice. Then, write about the beginning, middle, and end. If you read a non-fiction book, write three facts about the story.</p>	<p>Write a math story problem and have someone solve it. The problem must be multi-step. Your problem can be addition, subtraction, multiplication or division.</p>	<p>Make something creative out of recycled materials. Send a picture of your creation to your teacher on DOJO.</p>
<p>Read a book of your choice. Design a movie poster for the book.</p>	<p>Ask a family member to provide a recipe for one of your favorite desserts. Now, imagine that you are making this recipe for 50 people. Rewrite the recipe by doubling or tripling the ingredients to have enough for 50 people.</p>	<p>Draw a picture of your favorite part of your Winter Break. Add as many details to your picture as you can remember. Then, color it using the art tool of your choice, crayons, colored pencils, markers, or water color paint.</p>
<p>Build a blanket fort! Turn off the lights! Grab a book and read with a flashlight. Send a picture of your fort to your teacher on dojo!</p>	<p>Make a list of 5 ways multiplication or division is used in the real world.  Make another list of 5 ways geometry is used in the real world</p>	<p>Get 4 ice cubes. Find 4 different ways to try to melt the cubes. Which way melted the fastest? Which way was the slowest? Write a paragraph to tell what you learned.</p>
